Purpose and legal basis

Log data

Every time you visit a website, your Internet browser automatically transmits information to our web server for technical reasons (so-called log data). We store some of this information in log files, for example

- Date of access
- Time of the access
- URL of the referring website
- retrieved file
- amount of data transferred
- browser type and version
- operating system
- IP address

We only process log data in order to fix website errors or to manage security incidents.

To fix website or to preserve evidences in the event of security incidents, it may be necessary for us to collect additional personal data with the log data. The legal basis is Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR our interest is the technical provision, security and optimization of the website.

Suppliers and Customers

We use contact and communication data and other relevant personal data from our suppliers and customers, insofar as they or their employees are natural persons. We process this data to carry out the business relationship, communication as well as to maintain business contacts.

The processing is based on Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR, our legitimate interest is customer relation management.

Job Applications

We regularly are advertising jobs online. You can submit your application via email. We will only process the data for the purpose of carrying out the application; data entered there is required for the initiation of an employment relationship and to enable communication in this regard and to process your request.

The processing is based on Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR (§ 26(1) BDSG).

Cookies

We do not use any Cookies on our Website!

Contact

On our website we have published our contact data as well as data of contact persons. If you get in touch with us, we process your contact data to get in touch with you and respond to your requests. The processing is based Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR, our legitimate interest is communication. If your request is related to a contract or a contract initiation, our processing is based on Art 6(1)(b) GDPR.

Recipients

For the implementation and operation of our website, we work with service providers who may receive personal data:

- Hosting service provider
- IT service provider
- Service provider for programming services
- Provider for video services

We only transfer your data to the recipients if this is necessary for the fulfillment of a contract with you or if there is a legitimate interest in the transfer of your data or if we have your consent for the transfer.

If we have obtained your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. For your withdrawal, please contact us at info@pacproject.com.

Storage duration

If we store your personal data, this will only be for a limited period of time and no longer than necessary. In principle, we delete your data when they are no longer necessary for the processing purpose for which they were collected, or other legal reasons exist that require deletion and there are no legal retention obligations or other legal reasons that make storage necessary.

Your Rights in connection with your personal data

You have the following rights by law in relation to your personal data. You can contact our data protection officer about this, including if you would like to know more about what these rights mean in detail.

Access to your data, Art.15 GDPR

You have the right to request access to whether or not we are processing personal data relating to you. If we process your personal data, you will receive information about the specific data and other additional information.

Rectification of your data, Art. 16 GDPR

You have the right to request that we rectify your data if it is incorrect, inaccurate and/or incomplete; the right to rectification includes the right to completion through supplementary explanations or notifications.

Erasure of your data "Right to be forgotten", Art. 17 GDPR

You have the right to request that we erase your personal data, if there is no longer a reason to keep it.

Restriction of the processing of your data by us. Art. 18 GDPR

You have the right to have the processing of your personal data restricted in certain cases for a specific scope.

Data portability, Art. 20 GDPR

You may have the right to request the return of data concerning you in a commonly used electronic, machine-readable data format.

The right to data portability includes the right to have the data transferred to another data controller; therefore, upon request, we will - to the extent technically feasible - transfer data directly to a data controller designated by you or yet to be designated. The right to data transfer exists only for data provided by you and requires that the processing is based on consent or for the performance of a contract and is carried out with the help of automated processes.

Objection to our processing of your data, Art. 21 GDPR

In the case of processing of personal data for the performance of tasks in the public interest (Art. 6(1)(e) GDPR) or for the performance of legitimate interests (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR), you may object to the processing of personal data relating to you at any time with effect for the future if there is no reason for further processing.

Withdrawal of a consent

If you have given us consent to process your personal data, you can withdraw this consent at any time and without giving reasons with effect for the future. For your withdrawal, please contact the contact point where you gave your consent or the data protection officer directly.

Complaints

You have the right, if you feel that we are not processing your personal data in accordance with data protection, to contact us or our data protection officer at the above contact details. Furthermore, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the responsible supervisory authority when it comes to the processing of your personal data, Art. 77 GDPR.
